Firstly, thank you for your participation in China Aid 2007 jointly hosted by Shanghai Civil Affairs Bureau, Shanghai Disabled Persons' Federation and Council for Promotion of International Trade Shanghai and co-organized by Shanghai Social Welfare Association, Shanghai Social Services, the Shanghai Disabled Person Supply Centre and INTEX Shanghai Co., Ltd. As an associated event of the 2007 Special Olympics World Summer Games, the 4th China Aid Show concluded with great success on Oct. 7th in INTEX Shanghai. This event is now one of the nation-wide brand names in the rehabilitation field and a top specialized trade fair.

The show space reached 6,000 sq.ms with nearly 100 exhibitors from 12 countries participating, including the Germany, U.S.A, Canada, Holland, Britain, Italy, Belgium, Singapore, Japan, Korea, Taiwan province and China mainland. The show attracted many well-known local and international brands, such as INVACARE, VERMEIREN, VIMEC, SHOPRIDER, ThyssenKrupp, NISSIN, MIKI, MATSUNAGA, YUEYUE, Hu Bang, HuiZhong, etc. They all show their great care for the disadvantaged with their exhibits being market-leading examples of products for the disabled and the elderly, as well as displaying the

most modern and advanced products of this field.

The exhibits included special medical equipment, instruments for mobility, appliance for rehabilitation and nursing, special sanitary equipment, special bedroom accessories, special studying and communicating equipment, barrier-free facilities, etc.

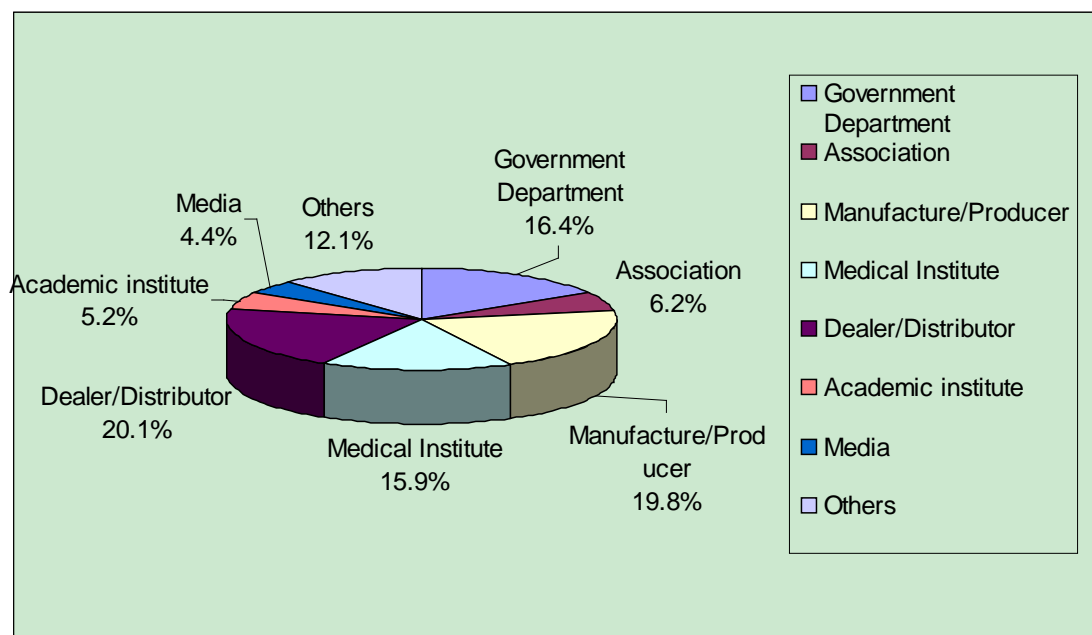
### About the visitors

International and domestic guests of 2007 Special Olympics World Summer Games, specialists of Civil Affairs, Disabled persons' federations from all provinces, franchisers, purchasing managers and decision-makers of rehabilitation centre, hospital, nursing and healthcare field were invited to join the show and attended the meetings. What's more, during the show, the organizers invited representatives from Shanghai Municipal Government, Community Welfare Dept. of Civil Administration Ministry, China Disabled Persons' Federation, Shanghai Civil Affairs Bureau, Shanghai Disabled Persons' Federation, and Council for the Promotion of International Trade Shanghai as special guests to come to the show.

### Visitor Statistics (Nature of Business)

The fair brought together 6286 trade visitors. According to the nature of business, the main part is Dealer/ Distributor (accounting for 20.1%), the second is Manufacture/Producer company (accounting for 19.8%), the third is Government Department (accounting for 16.4%), and the fourth is Medical Institution (accounting for 15.9%).

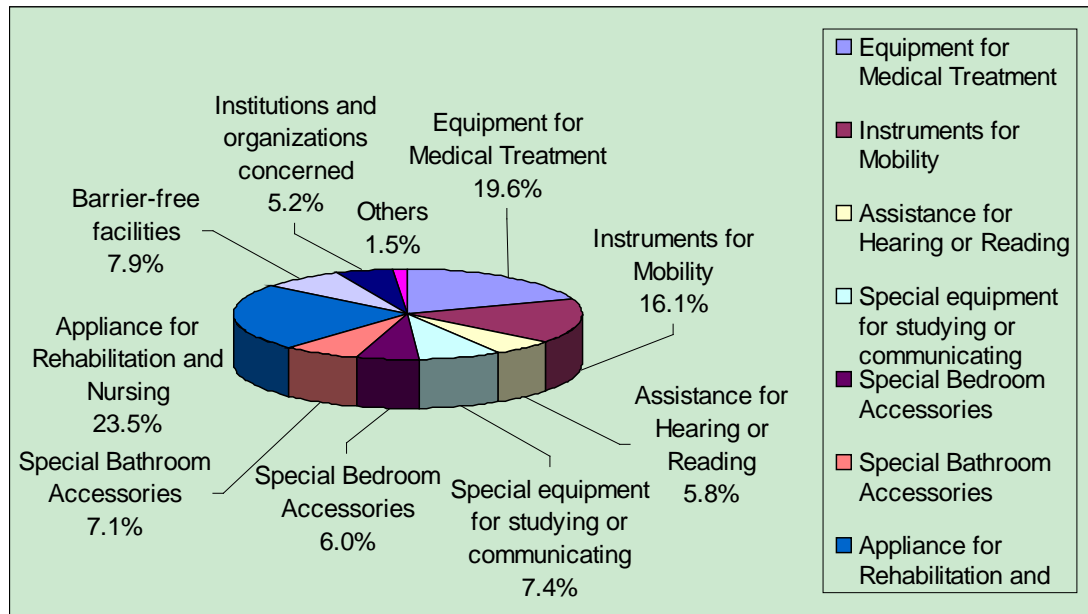

### Visitor Statistics (Main area of interest)

The rehabilitation and nursing facility had the largest proportions (accounting for 23.5%), the second is medical treatment appliance (accounting for 19.8%), the third is instruments for mobility (accounting for 16.1%), and the fourth is barrier-free facility (accounting for 7.9%).

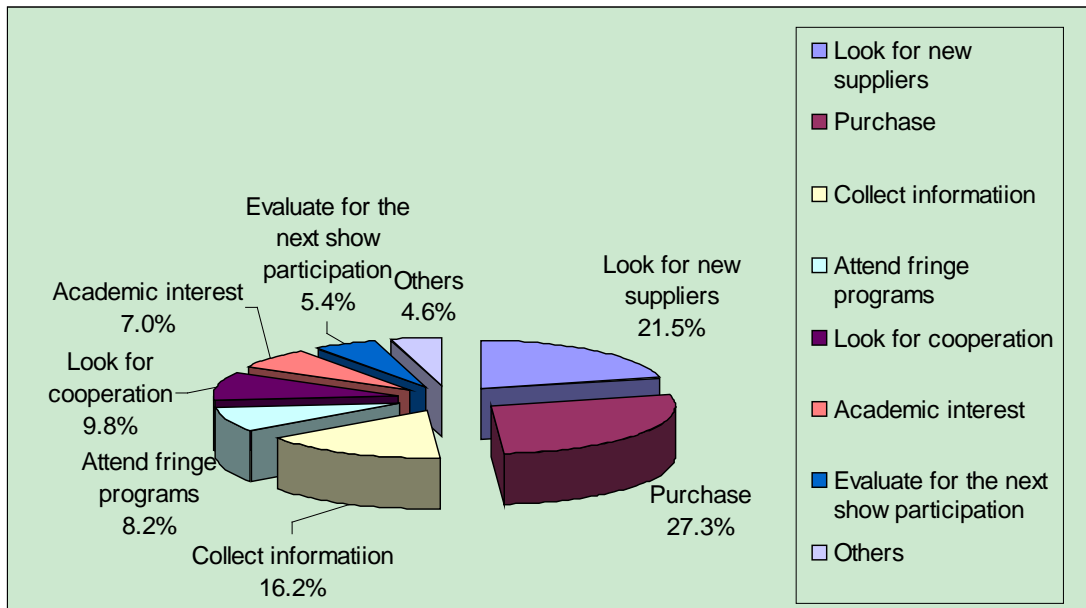

### Visitor Statistics (Main aim of visiting)

### Seminar and information release conference won acceptance

### **Comprehensive on-site service, people-oriented**

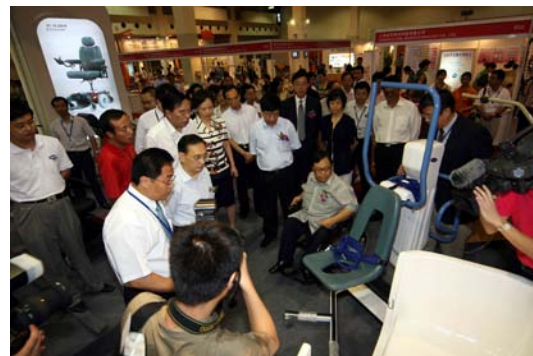
